DECREE OF DIVORCE

Now on this day comes plaintiff in person and by attorney and defendant although duly and lawfully summoned by personal service, comes not but makes default.

THIS CAUSE NOW COMING ON FOR TRIAL IS SUBMITTED TO THE COURT UPON THE PLEADINGS AND AFTER HAVING HEARD THE EVIDENCE THE COURT FINDS THAT THE ALLEGATIONS IN plaintiff's PETITION ARE TRUE; THAT plaintiff IS THE INJURED AND INNOCENT PARTY AND ENTITLED TO THE RELIEF PRAYED.

WHEREFORE IT IS ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT, THAT THE BONDS OF MATRIMONY HERETOFORE CONTRACTED BETWEEN PLAINTIFF AND DEFENDANT BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY DIS-SOLVED AND FOR NAUGHT HELD AND plaintiff

FOREVER FREED FROM THE OBLIGATIONS THEREOF.

It is further ordered and adjudged by the court that the plaintiff be and she is hereby awarded care, custody and control of minor child, vis., Bessie Kershaw, born of said marriage relations; that defendant to have privilege of taking said child on first Saturday of every month, to some suitable place and to return said child Sunday by 6:00'clock P.M., Defendant to have child for month of July every year and Christmas week, but to return child before New Year's day. In case defendant cannot take child at times mentioned, he must give plaintiff ten days notice.

It is further ordered by the Court that plaintiff be allowed alimony for support of said child the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars per week, to begin on Saturday, October 12, 1918, and a like sum on each and every Saturday thereafter until the further order of this Court.

IT IS further ordered by the Court that said child must not be taken out of Missouri by either plaintiff or defendant.

Wherefore, it is ordered and adjudged by the Court that the plaintiff have and recover of and from said defendant, the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars, per week, as alimony for the support of said minor child, payable as above indicated, together with all costs herein and have therefor execution.
