In the depths of the White Oak Grove is the final resting place of some who have gone before us. Recollection is that a rail fence on the south identified the location of about 30 tombstones. Only 2 are visible now. One marker reads "Robert J. Gray, age 34, died 1854". The other Lucy, wife of Guilford Richards", "Remember me as I pass by, as you are now, so once was I".
