

OBITUARY.

A. M. Sloan was born October 2, 1830, in Iredell county, North Carolina, and departed this life, April 5, 1913, near Ekeland, Wisconsin, aged 83 years, 5 months and three days. He came to Missouri in 1859 and resided in Buchanan county, moving from there to Holt county in 1870, where he resided until March 25, when he removed to Wisconsin.
